Artificial Intelligence have taken many shapes and forms over recent years.

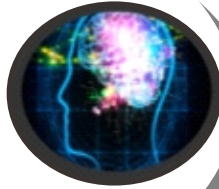

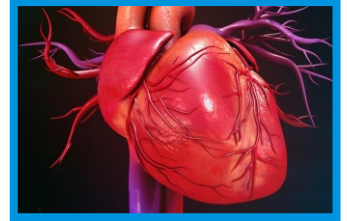




WHY DO I HAVE

The heart pumps blood to every cell in your body.



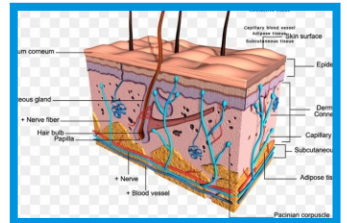
Lungs

Each breath you inhale fills balloons like organs with oxygen. Each Exhalation exhales Carbon-Di-Oxide waste from your body.



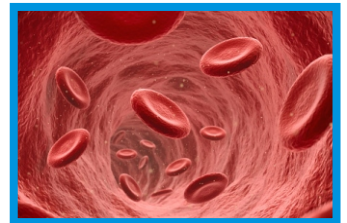
Skin.....

Skin is the largest organ of your body. It holds your insides in and protects your tissues from ultraviolet radiations.



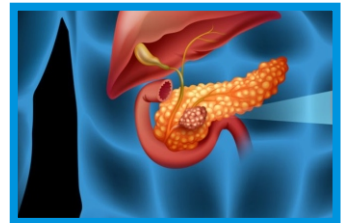
Blood.....

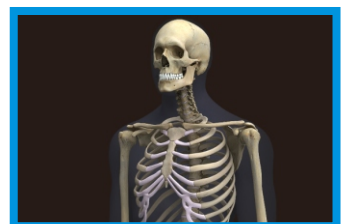
A Pancreas....

Events of The Month

हिन्दी दिवस



1 सितंबर से 14 सितंबर तक हिंदी दिवस के उपलक्ष्य में “दून इंटरनेशनल पब्लिक स्कूल” में आयोजित ‘हिंदी पखवाड़ा’ मनाया गया, जिसके अंतर्गत विभिन्न प्रतियोगिताओं का आयोजन किया गया। प्रतियोगिताओं में छात्रों ने बहुत ही हर्ष और उत्साह के साथ भाग लिया। छात्रों ने शिक्षकों के निर्देशानुसार 1 सितंबर से 14 सितंबर तक अपने विद्यालय एवं घरों में अधिक से अधिक हिंदी भाषा का प्रयोग करने का संकल्प लिया।

छात्रों ने पोस्टर और सुलेख प्रतियोगिताओं के माध्यम से अपनी भावनाओं को व्यक्त
